## Sapper Edward John Ezard

B Coy, Signal Corps, Royal Engineers- Son of Mr. and Mrs. J Ezard of Manchester-Husband of Priscilla Ezard, 32, Newton Cottages, The Friary, Salisbury- Father of 1 and 5 year old- Born in Lancashire in 1883- Died in hospital 24<sup>th</sup> August 1914 after being crushed by a lorry.


Buried in Bavay Communal Cemetery, France (12 graves) South Part.



## **Private George Hawkins**

1<sup>st</sup> Battalion Duke of Cornwall Light Infantry- Son of George and Caroline Hawkins, 21 Trinity Street, Salisbury- Born in 1887 in Shrewton- He was part of the famous Mon's retreat- His body was never found- Died on 21<sup>st</sup> October 1914. (818 died on that day).

Commemorated on Le Touret Memorial, France. Panel 19.



## **Private Reginald William Liversidge**

1<sup>st</sup> Dorsetshire Regiment- Son of George and Ellen Liversidge of 55, Culver Street, Salisbury- Born in 1892 in Salisbury- He was killed during the La Bassee/Armentieres battles- His body was never found- Died on 22<sup>nd</sup> October 1914

Commemorated on Le Touret Memorial, France. Panel 22.



## **Corporal Thomas James Gascoigne**

Shoeing Smith, 70th Battery Royal Field Artillery- Husband of Edith Ellen Gascoigne, 54 Barnard Street, Salisbury- Born in Croydon in 1887-Died on wounds on 30<sup>th</sup>

Buried in St Nazaire Toutes Aides Cemetery, France. Plot D 57.



#### **Private William Stevens**

1st Battalion Wiltshire Regiment- Husband of Betty Louisa Stevens of 52, Waterloo Gardens, Salisbury- Born in Bishopstone, Wiltshire in 1883-Died 21<sup>st</sup> September 1914.

Buried in Braine Communal Cemetery, France. A10 Special Memorial





## Private Albert (S confused with his brother Alfred S) Edwin Mortimer

2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Wiltshire Regiment- Son of Edward and Eliza Mortimer of 53, Culver Street, Salisbury- Born in 1888 in Salisbury- Died in the trenches at Pont de la Justice, France on 15<sup>th</sup> January 1915.

Buried in Rue David Military Cemetery, Fleurbaix, France. Plot 1G 29



## Rifleman Oliver William Chapman

2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Kings Royal Rifle Corps-Son of Henry and Louisa Chapman of 91 Culver Street, Salisbury- Born in Sandown, Isle of Wight in 1897-Died on 10<sup>th</sup> January 1915.

Commemorated on Le Touret Memorial, France. Panel 32/33



#### **Corporal William Finlay Partridge**

Royal Army Medical Corps- Husband of M E Partridge of 52 Barnard Street, Salisbury- Killed in action by shelling whilst recovering unit's equipment from Bethune- Born Derbyshire in 1879-Died 25<sup>th</sup> January 1915.

Buried in Chocques Military Cemetery, France. Plot 1A 1

## Lance Corporal Cecil George Sandbrook Rawlings

12<sup>th</sup> London Battalion, The Rangers- Eldest son of George and Ida Rawlings of Rosemount, Milford-His family owned a business in Salisbury.-Born in Salisbury in 1895- Educated at Godolphin Kindergarten- He was killed in action just east of Ypres when a shell exploded in the trench- He died 15<sup>th</sup> February 1915.

Buried in Sanctuary Wood Cemetery, Belgium. Plot 11B 1/3



## **Private Frederick Massey**

1<sup>st</sup> Wiltshire Battalion- Son of Edward and Annie Massey of St Martins Street, Salisbury- Born in Salisbury in 1892- Killed in action on 30<sup>th</sup> March 1915.

Buried in Voormezeele Enclosure Cemetery No 3, Belgium. Plot 1V B1.



#### **Private George Gray**

Royal Army Service Corp-.Husband of Annie Laura Gray, 59, The Friary, Salisbury- Born in Salisbury in 1882- Died at home of a painful illness on 21<sup>st</sup> March 1915- He was a father of 5 children.

Buried in London Road Cemetery, Salisbury. Plot P 661.



#### **Private Alfred Morris**

1<sup>st</sup> Royal Dragoons-Son of James and Emily Morris of 14 Albert Place, The Friary, Salisbury-Born in Pitton in 1886 -Killed in the trenches near Hooge on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 1915.

Commemorated on Menin Gate, Ypres, Belgium. Panel 5.



## Private Sidney William Jack Pitman

2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Wiltshire Regiment-Son of Sidney and Emma Louisa Pitman of 39, Rampart Road, Salisbury- Born in Salisbury in 1895- He was leading a section against the German trenches at Givenchy; when he was struck by shrapnel and died almost immediately on 15<sup>th</sup> June 1915.

Commemorated on Le Touret Memorial, France Panel 33/34.



## **Lance Corporal James Cull**

Military Police- Born Gussage All Saints, Dorset- Husband of Elizabeth Cull 19, Clarendon Road, Salisbury- Born in 1880 in Salisbury-Died at Military Isolation Hospital, Aldershot on 10<sup>th</sup> August 1915.

Buried in London Road Cemetery, Salisbury, Plot O 378.



#### **Private Albert William Jeans**

6<sup>th</sup> Battalion Leinster Regiment- Son of George and Fanny Jeans of 110, Milford Hill, Salisbury- Husband of Edith Emma Jeans of Lower Woodford- Born in 1886 in Alderbury- Killed in action defending Rhodendron Spur, Gallipoli on 10<sup>th</sup> August 1915.

Commemorated on Helles Memorial, Turkey, Panel 184/185.



## **Private Charles Cobb**

5<sup>th</sup> Battalion Wiltshire Regiment. Son of Frank and Ellen Elizabeth Cobb of 105, Culver Street, Salisbury. Born in 1897 in Salisbury. Killed in action at the Battle of Sari Bair 10<sup>th</sup> August 1915.

Commemorated on Helles Memorial, Turkey. Panel 156/158



## **Private William Henry John Fry**

5<sup>th</sup> Battalion Wiltshire Regiment-Son of Harry and Mary Fry of 53, Paynes Hill, Salisbury- Born in 1898 in Marlborough- Died aboard the Hospital Ship Guildford Castle of wounds received at Damakielik Bair on 14<sup>th</sup> August 1915.

Commemorated on Helles Memorial, Turkey. Panel 156/158



### **Private Stanley John Swayne**

2/4<sup>th</sup> Battalion Wiltshire Regiment- Son of Thomas and Fanny Swayne of 1 Waverley Place, Gigant Street, Salisbury- Born 1894 in Salisbury- Died of illness on 20<sup>th</sup> September 1915.

Buried St Sepulchre's Cemetery, Poona, India. Grave 133.

1<sup>st</sup> Battalion Wiltshire Regiment- Husband of Matilda Beaven 46, Ashley Road, Salisbury- Born in 1882 in Salisbury- Killed in action during a bombardment by the German trenches at Ypres on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 1915.

2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Wiltshire Regimen- Son of Charles William and late Sarah Burbage, 26 Trinity Street, Salisbury- Born in 1897 in Salisbury- Died on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the Battle of Loos on 25<sup>th</sup> September 1915.

## Lance Sergeant Frank Allan Vincent

2<sup>nd</sup> Middlesex Regiment -Son of George and Harriette Vincent of Amity Grove, Wimbledon-Born in1894 in Stradbroke, Suffolk-Died 14<sup>th</sup> March 1915.

## **Captain James Herrick Mc Gregor**

16<sup>th</sup> Manitoba Regiment- Husband of Elizabeth F G W McGregor, Oak Bay, Victoria. BC.- Born in 1874 in British Columbia- Died in 2<sup>nd</sup> Battle of Ypres at St Julien on 24th April 1915.

5<sup>th</sup> Connaught Rangers (Part of the new Kitchener's Army)- Son of Alfred and Laura Ann Sennett of Joiners Hall, St Anne Street, Salisbury- Born in 1889 in Salisbury- Died of his wounds on 17<sup>th</sup> January 1916.

Commemorated on Dorian Memorial, Greece. East Face. Column 1



#### **Private Charles Frederick Bunsell**

2<sup>nd</sup> Wiltshire Regiment- Son of George and Elizabeth Jane Bunsell of 6, Park Terrace, The Friary, Salisbury- Born in 1896 in Salisbury- Died in action from numerous shrapnel wounds on 4th February 1916.

Buried in Corbie Communal Cemetery, France. Plot 1D 36.



### Sapper Charles Harry Robinson

Royal Engineers 90<sup>th</sup> Field Company- Husband of Susan Robinson 9, Clifton Row, West Street, Salisbury- Born in 1879 in Alderbury-Died of wounds on 4<sup>th</sup> April 1916.

Buried in London Rifle Brigade Cemetery Belgium. Plot 2B8.



#### Seaman Kenneth Alder

Royal Navy-Son of Isaac John and Flora Thirza Alder of 24, St Martins Church Street, Salisbury- Born in 1898 in Salisbury- He was aboard the Indefatigable when it was sunk during the Battle of Jutland and died on 31<sup>st</sup> May 1916, along with 1017 others who were on board that day.

Commemorated on Portsmouth Naval Memorial, Panel 12.



### Private (Henry) George Elliott

Royal Marines Light Infantry- Son of Harriet Elliott of Exeter Street, Salisbury- Born in 1897 in Salisbury- He was aboard HMS Black Prince when it was sunk during the Battle of Jutland and died on 31<sup>st</sup> May 1916, along with 857 who were on board that day.

Commemorated on the Portsmouth Naval War Memorial Panel 22.



## **Private Walter John Sanger**

1st Wiltshire Regiment- Husband of Mable Sanger of 15a, Gigant Street, Salisbury.-Born in 1888 in Fittleton, Wiltshire- Killed in action on the Leipzig Salient as the result of high explosive bombardment on 7<sup>th</sup> July 1916.

Buried in AIF Cemetery, Flers, France. Plot 15 E7.



## Sergeant William Frank Welsh

1<sup>st</sup> Wiltshire Regiment- Son of William and Sarah Anne Welsh of 103, Culver Street, Salisbury- Born in 1894 in Redbourne, Wiltshire- Killed in action in the trenches on the Leipzig Salient on 6<sup>th</sup> July 1916.

Buried in Lonsdale Cemetery, France. Plot 3 F7.



## **Private Edgar Percy Rousell**

Duke of Cambridge's Own 1<sup>st</sup> Middlesex- Son of William James Rousell of 66, St Mark's Road, Salisbury- Born in 1896 in Salisbury- Killed in action SE of Pozieres and died 15<sup>th</sup> July 1916.

Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial Panel, France. Panel 12D/13B



## **Leading Seaman Francis Henry Jolliffe**

Royal Navy.-Son of Frederick William and Eliza Jane Jolliffe of 8 Park Terrace, The Friary, Salisbury- Born in 1884 in Salisbury- He was aboard submarine E4 when it was sunk in collision with submarine E41 just off Harwich and died 15<sup>th</sup> August 1916. His body was never recovered, so only has his name on memorial.

Commemorated on Submarine Memorial, Shotley, Harwich, Suffolk, UK



### **Lance Corporal Frederick Short**

1<sup>st</sup> Wiltshire Regiment -Husband of Mildred Short of Salisbury-Born in 1889 in Salisbury.-Killed in action in the trenches in the Leipzig Salient during German Bombardment on 20th August 1916.

Buried in Blighty Valley, Authulie, France. Plot 1C22.



## **Lance Corporal Edgar Robert Foakes**

Royal Dublin Fusiliers.-Son of Charles and Elizabeth Foakes of 5 Park Terrace, The Friary, Salisbury- Born 1893 in Maddington, Wiltshire- Killed in action near Struma River on the Greek /Bulgarian border fighting the Bulgarians- Died 23<sup>rd</sup> September 1916.

Buried Stuma Military Cemetery, Greece. Plot 2D13.



## 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant Eric Tomlinson Martin

Duke of Cornwall Light Infantry- Son of Edward and Amy Martin of Croydon- Born in Croydon in 1896-Died 1<sup>st</sup> October 1916.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant Eric Wallace Ware

2<sup>nd</sup> Wiltshire Regiment-Son of Hubert and Sarah Ware of Milford, Salisbury- Born in 1896 in Salisbury- Died 18<sup>th</sup> October 1916

Buried in Caterpillar Valley, Longueval, France. Plot VI A1.



### **Private Arthur Edward Chambers**

Canadian Infantry Central Ontario Regiment-Son of John and Sarah of Gigant Street, Salisbury-. Born in 1888 in Alderbury -Died 28<sup>th</sup> October 1916 in Fort Pitt Hospital Chatham from wounds received in France- He was a member of St Martin's Choir, Lads Brigade and Bible Class- Funeral took place at St Martin's.

Buried in London Road Cemetery, Salisbury, Plot L90.



## **Sergeant Harry Palmer**

1<sup>st</sup> Wiltshire Regiment- Son of John and Mary Ann Palmer, Ivy Cottage, Southampton Road, Salisbury- Born 1894 in St Luke's London-Died 23<sup>rd</sup> December 1916.

## Captain William Bramwell Pepper

Royal Garrison Artillery-Son of Lieutenant Colonel G N Pepper of Salisbury-Born in 1883 in Alderbury-Died 4<sup>th</sup> August 1916 during Battle of the Somme.

Buried in Dantzig Alley British Cemetery, France. Plot 1 A 32.

5<sup>th</sup> Wiltshire Regiment- Husband of Emily Smith, 99 Culver Street, Salisbury-Father of 5 children- Born 1882 in Framlingham, Suffolk- Killed in action whilst capturing Turkish trenches at Hai Salient on 25<sup>th</sup> January 1917.

Buried in Amara War Cemetery, Iraq. Plot 17 B8 (Unfortunately this cemetery now lies in ruins; cross of sacrifice in photo was blown up)



## **Private Edwin Goodearl Cripps (Cripp on memorial)**

Royal Fusiliers-Son of William and Ellen Cripps of Byways Guesthouse, Salisbury-Born in 1895 in High Wycombe- Died of wounds on 27<sup>th</sup> January 1917.

Buried in Bethune Town Cemetery. France. 6A 81



## Private (James) Albert Baugh

Army Service Company- Husband of Beatrice Maud Baugh, St Martins Street, Salisbury- Born in 1889 in Salisbury- Found drowned in Abbeville 19<sup>th</sup> February 1917.

Buried in Abbeville Communal Cemetery, France. Plot 2 E1.



## **Private Henry Jole Batt**

**L**einster Regiment-Husband of Gitana Batt- Born 1892 in Bath, Somerset- Died 1<sup>st</sup> April 1917.

#### **Private Frederick Crutcher**

Leinster Regiment- Husband of Mena Mary Crutcher of 45, North Street, Wilton-Born in 1886 in Salisbury- Died of wounds at No1 Casualty Clearing Station on 2nd April 1917.

## **Private Harry Victor White**

2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Wiltshire Regiment- Son of Charles and E White of 11, Exeter Terrace, Salisbury- Born in 1897 in Harnham, Salisbury- Killed in action as they attacked the Hindenburg Line and died on 9<sup>th</sup> April 1917.

Commemorated on Arras Memorial Bay 7.



#### **Private Arthur Hart**

Possibly Alfred Ernest Hart of Wiltshire Regiment- Son of Agnes and Arthur Hart Culver Street, Salisbury- Born in Salisbury- He was a St Martin's Parishioner. Killed in action on 27<sup>th</sup> May 1916.

58<sup>th</sup> Signal Company Royal Engineers- Son of Sidney and Ada Macey of 70, York Road, Salisbury- Born in 1895 in Salisbury- Killed in action east of Arras on 13<sup>th</sup> May 1917.

## Private (Sidney) George Burbage

2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Dorsetshire Regiment.-Son of Charles and Sarah Burbage, 26, Trinity Street, Salisbury- Born in 1889 in Salisbury- Killed in action in the Maude's Offensive on died 25<sup>th</sup> March 1917.

#### **Private Alfred Conduit**

1<sup>st</sup> Wiltshire Regiment- Son of William and Harriet Conduit, Salisbury.-Born in Salisbury in 1886- Killed in action in the Wulverghem sector on 5<sup>th</sup> June 1917.

#### **Private Charles William Andrews**

6<sup>th</sup> Battalion Wiltshire Regiment- Lived with Aunt and Uncle at 15, Trinity Street, Salisbury-Born in Deal in 1894-Died 16<sup>th</sup> June 1917.

Royal Marine Light Infantry HMS Tamar-Son of Henry and Julia Amor of 18, Milford Hill, Salisbury.-Born in 1887 in Dewlish, Somerset- Died 18<sup>th</sup> July 1917 of pneumonia.

## Sergeant Albert James Musselwhite

5<sup>th</sup> Wiltshire Regiment-Husband of Alice Musselwhite, 47 Rampart Road, Salisbury-Born in Salisbury in 1885- Died of illness at Casualty Clearing Station in Mesopotamia on 19<sup>th</sup> July 1917

Buried Baghdad North Gate War Cemetery, Iraq. Plot 15 B3



### **Private Edward Percy Lott Horne**

1<sup>st</sup> Battalion Somerset Light Infantry- Born in Salisbury in 1898-Grandson of Mrs Mary Horne, 32 Meadow Cottages, The Friary, Salisbury- Killed in Action East of Arras on 27th July 1917.

Buried Feuchy Chapel British Cemetery, Wancourt, France Plot 2 F2.



#### **Private Sidney Hubert Uphill**

1/5th Durham Light Infantry- Son of Herbert and Harriet Uphill, St Martins, Salisbury- Born in Salisbury in 1882- Captured in the Arras offensive and died from wounds received as a POW on 10th August 1917.

Buried at Tourcoing Communal Cemetery, France. Plot O6



## **Private Harry Brown**

Royal Inniskillin Fusiliers-Son of George and Lucy Brown, 45 Clarendon Road, Elm Grove, Salisbury- Born in 1898 in Salisbury, Wiltshire-Killed in action on 10<sup>th</sup> August 1917.

#### **Private John Thomas Cook**

1<sup>st</sup> Wiltshire Regimen-Son of Eva Cook, The Close, Salisbury-Born in 1888 in Salisbury- Killed on 11<sup>th</sup> August 1917, whilst strengthening the line between Bellewarde and Westhoek.

Commemorated on Menin Gate Memorial, Belgium. Panel 30



## **Private Robert John Huggins**

Royal Inniskillen Fusilier-Son of Francis and Emma Huggins, Bemerton- Born in 1898 in Salisbury -Captured by Germans at Langemark and died in captivity on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 1917.



Oxford and Bucks Light Infantry-Husband of Eliza Burton, 63 Rampart Road, Salisbury- Born in Salisbury in 1889-Killed in action on 9<sup>th</sup> September 1917.

## Private Sidney New Massey.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wiltshire Regiment-Son of Edward and Annie Massey, Rampart Road, Salisbury-Born in St Luke's, London in 1886-He was company stretcher bearer and died from severe stomach wounds he sustained on the previous day on 12<sup>th</sup> September 1917.

#### Private Bertram John Gardner

2<sup>nd</sup> Royal Warwickshire Regiment-Son of George and Naomi Gardner, 29 Meadow Cottages-Born in Salisbury in 1889-Killed in action at the Battle of Poelcapelle on 9<sup>th</sup> October 1917.

## **Private Ernest Sidney Phillips**

#### **Private Walter Musselwhite**

5<sup>th</sup> Suffolk Regiment-Husband of Frances Musselwhite, 13 Meadow Cottages, The Friary-Born in Salisbury in 1883-Died of wounds received while digging trenches in Ypres Salient on 11<sup>th</sup> January 1917.


